

INFORMATION FOR HEALTH PROVIDERS

1. Refer via DCAS using the SCTT General Practice Referral Form (see below)
2. If there is a GP Management Plan please attach to the referral
3. DCAS will assess, triage, and refer or book an appropriate mix of services

The referral should include:

- Date of diagnosis
- Relevant blood results
 - FBG/OGTT (for newly diagnosed only)
 - HbA1c
 - Total Cholesterol, HDL, LDL, triglycerides
- Risk factors
 - BP
 - Smoking status
 - Height, weight and BMI
- Medication and medical history
