All above fees are reviewed and adjusted annually. Clients are notified with a minimum of one-month notice.

Basic Daily Fee

The basic daily fee is set by the government as a percentage of the single basic age pension. The basic daily fee is added to the government subsidy to increase the funds available to you in your Home Care Package budget. The Government sets the maximum amount a provider can charge, which is currently \$10.85 per day. Kooweerup Regional Health Service waive this fee for clients.

Income Asset Tested Fee

The income-tested care fee is an extra contribution that some people pay, as determined through an income assessment. This fee is different for everyone. It's based on individual income and assets including your pension. Whether you pay it, and how much of it you pay, is determined through a formal income assessment from Services Australia. If you are assessed as needing to pay the income-tested care fee you will receive a letter from Services Australia outlining the amount. This fee cannot be waived. You will receive an invoice from Kooweerup Regional Health Service monthly to pay this contribution.

Levels of funding

There are four levels of Home Care Packages to help meet the different levels of care needs.

- Level 1: for people with basic care needs
- Level 2: for people with low-level care needs
- Level 3: for people with intermediate care needs
- Level 4: for people with high-level care needs.

Cancellations

All booked services that are cancelled with less than 24hrs notice will incur a cancellation fee equal to the amount of the booked service.

Home Unattended

Attendance by KRHS staff member to an unattended home shall incur a cancellation fee equal to the amount of the booked service.

Minimum Time

Minimum time refers to the minimum service period that can be booked for each service. Where the minimum time is N/A, there is no minimum time and the charges will be for services rendered only.

Definitions of Service

Personal care services

Help to maintain your personal hygiene and grooming, for example:

- bathing
- taking medication
- getting in and out of bed

Domestic assistance

Help to keep your living space clean and liveable, for example:

- general house cleaning
- clothes washing and ironing
- shopping

Meals and other food services

Help to ensure you continue to eat well, for example:

- meal delivery
- assistance with food preparation

Community Nursing services

At-home help to treat and monitor those with medical conditions.

Care Management: Care management is an essential key component of every Home Care Package. It ensures you receive the appropriate level of services and support in a way that meets your current and future care needs.

Care management may include:

- Reviewing your Home Care Agreement and Care Plan
- Coordination and scheduling of services
- Ensuring your care is aligned with other supports and services
- Providing a point-of-contact for you or your support network
- Identifying and addressing risks to your safety.

At Kooweerup Regional Health Service, Home Care Packages are fully managed - this means that Kooweerup Regional Health Service is fully responsible for your care management. Care management may be provided in different ways including face-to-face or via phone or email.

Allied health

Help to maintain strength and mobility, for example:

- physiotherapy
- occupational therapy
- dietitian

Home modification services

Help to increase or maintain your ability to move around your home, for example:

- grab rails
- ramps
- accessible bathroom redesign

Home maintenance services

Help to keep your home and garden in a safe condition, for example:

- fixing uneven flooring
- installing a security light
- clearing the yard of debris

Package Management: At Kooweerup Regional Health Service, the Package Management Fee includes - ongoing administration and organisational activities that ensure the smooth delivery and management of your Home Care Package. It may include the costs for:

- preparing monthly statements
- managing your package funds
- compliance and quality assurance activities required for Home Care Packages

It **does not** include costs that are unrelated to supporting your care, nor costs associated with running of business such as marketing, office rent, insurance, or activities completed before you enter into a Home Care Agreement with them.
